He had that same dream. Doug began playing in leagues and AAU teams that traveled all over the country. He was awarded many honors and gained much recognition as a pre-prep star player. He was invited to play on all star teams and won five MVP titles before his high school days began.

In high school, Doug was a four-year starter for his Varsity team:

- 3 years All County
- 2 years All State
- 2 years MVP
- Wes Del League MVP
- Conference Champ 2 Years
- Indiana High School Hall of Fame for over a thousand points scored
- Indiana High School Hall of Fame for 3pt. field goals and percentage

Doug went on to play at Purdue University for two years before following his other dream, which was music.

Doug coached JV Basketball at Pendleton Heights High School where, as an assistant, they won 2 Sectional Titles, 1 Regional Title, 3 Conference Titles and 1 Final Four appearance.

Doug is presently a founding member of the Ernie Haase & Signature Sound quartet. He is combining his two passions, music and basketball in this event to benefit Gwinnett Masters Special Olympics. Saturday, January 7, 2012, Doug will be leading a basketball clinic in the morning, followed by a musical concert in the evening at Mount Carmel Christian Church in Stone Mountain, GA.
